

International Graduate Application Checklist – University of New Orleans

Apply Complete and submit the **on-line application**. The fee is \$50 for applications received on or before the priority dates. Applications received after the University priority dates will be assessed a \$30 non-refundable late fee. **PLEASE NOTE:** some programs have earlier due dates. Application Priority Dates

Fall Semester.....June 1
Summer Session.....March 1
Spring Semester.....October 1

Transcripts Official transcripts from **all** colleges and universities you've attended (*regardless of credit or degree earned*) must be sent by the registrar of each respective institution to the Office of Admissions at UNO. Please note that we require a separate transcript from each university you have attended as well as an English translation. Have the transcripts sent to:

GRE/GMAT All applicants are required to submit official GRE or GMAT scores. Scores must be sent directly to the University of New Orleans from the testing agency. UNO's GRE institution code is 6379. Check which admissions test scores your program requires: <http://www.uno.edu/grad/ListofPrograms>

IELTS/TOEFL International applicants are required to provide evidence of English proficiency by either submitting official IELTS or TOEFL scores. Minimum University Requirements for the are as follows: 550 on the paper-based test TOEFL or 79 on the internet-based TOEFL or 6.5 overall band score on IELTS. Citizens of the United Kingdom, Australia, Canada (except Quebec), New Zealand, Ireland, Belize and certain Caribbean Islands, are NOT required to submit scores. Students who hold degree(s) from institutions within those countries or from U.S. universities are also exempt from the TOEFL requirement.

Financial Support Documents All international students are required to submit financial documents, such as bank statements, proving adequate financial support (approximately \$35,000 per academic year) throughout the term of their academic program.
