



# L.I.F.E Internship

## Student Participation Requirements

### Undergraduate Students

Minimum of 60 credit hours earned prior to beginning an internship

### Graduate Students

Minimum of 12 credit hours of graduate level coursework (6000 level) and a minimum 3.0 overall Graduate GPA

Internships must be approved by the faculty member who is responsible for overseeing the student through the internship period. In most instances, approval should be granted the semester prior to the internship

Although official internship agreements are not typically required; if an internship agreement is required by the Internship Partner between the University and the Partner, the Internship Coordinator should receive the agreement the semester prior to the internship semester to allow for legal review
