

## **Academic Advising**

All new undergraduate students and transfer students with 24 credit hours or less at The University of New Orleans are advised by Freshman Year Advisors in the Privateer Enrollment Center (PEC). Advising occurs in the PEC until students have earned 24 credit hours.

All students in the College of Education and Human Development who have earned 24 credit hours or more are advised by the Academic Counselor in the college office. Advising is mandatory until students earn 30 credit hours. After earning 30 hours or more mandatory advising is no longer required, but students are strongly encouraged to seek advising each semester by scheduling an appointment with the Academic Counselor.

All new graduate students in the Master of Arts in Teaching are required to be advised by the Academic Counselor in the college office. After the initial advising session all students are advised by a faculty member from the Department of Curriculum and Instruction or the Department of Special Education and Habilitative Services.
