### Free Elective and Science Elective Information

- The following courses may **not** be used for UNO **degree credit** by any major in the College of Sciences:

Any developmental or remedial course, e.g., DEVM 106, DEVM, 107, ENGL 150, ENGL 1156.

Any 1000 level MATH course, unless otherwise specified by a student's curriculum.

CHEM 1012

MATH 1021, 1023, 1031, 1032

PHYS 1001, 1002, 1003, 1004

- The following courses may be used as **free elective credit only**, not science elective credit, by majors in the College of Sciences:

BIOS 1053\*, 1063\*

CHEM 1001, 1002

CSCI 1000

PHYS 1010, 1020, 1030

\*May be taken to meet the General Degree requirement for Biology if allowed by the student's major department. A maximum of three credit hours in non-majors Biology may be used.

- Credit will not be given for courses that cover similar subject matter; for example, credit will be allowed for only one of the following courses: MATH 2314, MATH 2785, PSYC 1310, SOC 2707.
