Project going on for a year now, the hope is that by fall 2024 all students will be in workday rather than in webstar or peoplesoft and we will process all their registration and financial aid and fees in workday

Workday went live in jan 2021 with HR, payroll, finance, and grants. It's been an adventure

My hope is that we can get the word out that we work through the project and make sure that everyone is informed when this go-live occurs because it will impact everyone.

Timeline: the go-lives match the student life cycle

Academic foundation – all of the aspects of the institution (colleges, departments, grades, etc)

Recruiting and admissions – recently there was a decision to handle admissions through target x. we will need to integrate workday with TargetX. We'll need to test that integration.

Records, curriculum, and advising

Financial aid / student financials – things handled through the bursar

RIGHT NOW: in October, students applying for Fall 2024 will begin being entered in Workday

The MTP 2 is when we move all students (IE currently enrolled) to workday.

There will be a period when we've got students in both workday and peoplesoft.

Everything is going as planned and we're under budget!

Currently there is a process in peoplesoft that feeds student workers to workday. Workday student will mean we can get rid of that integration because the workday student will be integrated into staff workday.
