

## U.S. Citizen Graduate Application Checklist – University of New Orleans

**Apply** Complete and submit the **on-line application**. The fee is \$50 for applications received on or before the priority dates. Applications received after the University priority dates will be assessed a \$30 non-refundable late fee. *PLEASE NOTE:* some programs have earlier due dates. ### Application Priority Dates

*Fall Semester.....June 1*  
*Summer Session.....March 1*  
*Spring Semester.....October 1*

**Transcripts** Official transcripts from **all** colleges and universities you've attended (*regardless of credit or degree earned*) must be sent by the registrar of each respective institution to the Office of Admissions at UNO. Please note that we require a separate transcript from each university you have attended as well as an English translation. Have the transcripts sent to:

**GRE/GMAT** All applicants are required to submit official GRE or GMAT scores. Scores must be sent directly to the University of New Orleans from the testing agency.
