Our Campus Mail is operated as a Contract Postal Unit (CPU) by Novitex Enterprise Solutions. (It is not an actual "Post Office".)The university went through a competitive bid process and Novitex was the lowest bidder. The university pays Novitex for their management services and as such we want the expense to the university to be as low as possible. Novitex has the ability to accept credit cards but the university would have to pay the credit card fees. The university is not in a financial position to pay additional fees for credit card services.
