



Connecting Android to UNOSECURE

1. Open the Application launcher and tap **Settings**



2. Tap **Wireless & networks**



3. Tap **Wi-Fi** to turn it on, if it is not already checked.




Result: Wi-Fi should now be checked.




4. Tap **Wi-Fi settings**.




Result: You should see a list of available Wi-Fi networks.




5. Tap on **UNOSECURE**, and then tap on **Connect to network**.




NOTE: On HTC Android devices, you may be prompted to set a password for your credential storage prior to connecting to UNOSECURE. This password must be 8 characters long.




Result: A connection screen should appear with a variety of security options.



6. Leaving all other options as default (EAP method should be PEAP, and all others should be "None" or "unspecified"), enter your UNO username for "Identity" and your UNO password for "Password". Tap **Connect**.



Result: Under UNOSECURE, you should now see the word "Connected". You are now connected to UNO's secure wireless network.
