

Email Setup for iPhone

1. Navigate to your Settings menu. From the Settings menu, click **Mail, Contacts, and Calendars**.





2. From the Mail, Contacts, Calendar menu click Add Account.

5. Enter the following information:

Email: <u>username@my.uno.edu</u> (this should be automatically there) Server: **outlook.office365.com** or **pod51008.outlook.com** (either will work) Domain: Leave blank Username: <u>username@uno.edu</u> Password: (Should already be there)

Then tap **Done**.

6. Your phone will now ask you what you want to sync. You can sync mail, contacts, calendars, reminders and notes from your account. Once you've made your selections, click **Save**.
