

Setting up Email on a Nexus 7

- 1. Make sure you're connected to a Wi-Fi network.
- 2. Touch the all programs button and select **Settings**.



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3. Scroll down to Accounts and select + Add account.

10. Give the account a name, and then select **Next**.

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11. An "**Activate device Administrator**" window will appear, select **Activate** (required). As with the previous EAS prompt, this is a default prompt from the device. UNO does not remotely control user's device.



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12. When the setup is completed, the setup window will close. To check if your Nexus 7 is properly receiving email, calendar, or contact, navigate and launch each of the respective apps.
