## LSUHSC - New Orleans Bachelor of Science in Public Health

Listed below are the prerequisite courses for admission to the Bachelor of Science in Public Health (BSPH) Program at the LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans School of Public Health.

Program requirements are determined by LSUHSC. Admission to the program is on a competitive basis. Applicants are evaluated and accepted by the admissions committee based on their academic credentials, work and service experience. Transcripts for each college/ university attended are required, along with a Letter of Interest. Admissions will be made on a rolling basis after January 1 of each year.

Students enter the BSPH program after completion of the prerequisite courses and at least 60 credit hours at a college or university with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 .
