## What is CPAE?

- The Certified Performing Arts Executive Program is a series of online intensive professional level classes on core issues addressed by U.S. presenters of performing arts and by agents and managers representing touring artists.
- The Program designers are drawn from industry leaders among agents and managers, presenters, and academia to provide a balanced and up-to-date curriculum.
- The Program teachers are drawn from the top of the industry: practicing professionals responsible for touring and presenting performing arts in small and large communities throughout the U.S. and Canada.
- The Program reflects current trends, best practices, and an opportunity to learn first hand the practical realities faced on a daily basis by professionals in the field.
- Topics covered in the 8 intensive 3-hour sessions include legal issues, negotiation, funding, marketing, strategic planning and curating.
- The Program balances and examines both sides of the "seller/buyer" equation to heighten success and build win-win relationships.
- The classes, while structured, leave room for discussion of the individual interests of the participants.

- Early or mid-career professionals seeking knowledge and certification to advance in their career paths.
- Professionals in the field seeking a deeper understanding of the "other side" of engagement booking to increase their effectiveness and achieve greater success.
- Staff members at presenting institutions interested in moving to the agent/artist management side, and vice versa.
- Artists seeking a greater understanding of the business environment in which their work is presented to gain additional management control of their careers.
- Volunteers at performing arts centers seeking to qualify for employment.
- Professionals in other fields seeking to join the exciting world of performing arts representation and presenting.
- Arts managers from other countries who want to deepen their understanding of North American policies and practice.
