- ____ 1. Interpreting Literature: ENGL 2258 (3 hrs.)
[Students who switch to English and have already taken a combination of ENGL 2238 and ENGL 2208, 2228, or 2248, may substitute those two classes for ENGL 2258. If students have credit for only one of those courses, they can and should take ENGL 2258.]
- ____ 2. Survey courses (Choose 3): ____ ENGL 2341, ____ ENGL 2342, ____ ENGL 2031, ____ ENGL 2032 (9 hrs.)
- ____ 3. Diversity course (Choose 1): ____ ENGL 2071, ____ ENGL 2072, ____ ENGL 2378, ____ ENGL 2091 (3 hrs.)
- ____ 4. Methods courses (Both required): ____ Introduction to Theory ENGL 3381 and ____ Methods of Research and Writing ENGL 3382 (6 hours)
- ____ 5. ____ Upper-level open English elective option (18 hours). Six additional English, journalism or related courses, *at least **five** of which must be at the **3000-4000 level***. Students may select from all offerings, including Anglophone literature, literature in translation, translation studies, editing, media studies, journalism, professional writing, rhetoric, or internship.
