## A Bill

This is a bill to allocate \$350.00 from the Senate Operating Account to assist the Educational Leadership Alliance in providing monies for both food and beverage and a nominal speaker fee for a Guest Speaker Series: How to Land a Tenure Track Position which will be hosted on Thursday, September 27<sup>th</sup> from 6:30pm-7:30pm in the Bicentennial building 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

Whereas, the Educational Leadership Alliance are registered with the Office of Student Involvement and Leadership.

Whereas, the Guest Speaker Series: How to Land a Tenure Track Position is necessary to the UNO community because it affords the UNO community an opportunity to hear from professionals in our respective field. All staff, faculty, and students are invited to participate in this discussion. Speakers who are high-profile or have substantial expertise require a nominal incentive, through speaker fees, to participate in current and future speaker series. Through this, we hope to attract more high-level talent and experts across the field of educational leadership to promote at UNO.

Whereas, the Guest Speaker Series: How to Land a Tenure Track Position will encourage participation from UNO's campus as well as neighboring schools for future speaker series. The hope is to create an enclave of practitioners or researchers who can come share expertise on numerous topics surrounding educational leadership. The primary means of marketing will be through a COLAEHD listserv. Additional publicizing will be done through flyers and informal class drop-ins.

Whereas, all UNO students, faculty, and staff as well as local community leaders are invited to attend.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW ORLEANS STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

- I. THE AMOUNT OF \$350.00 BE ALLOCATED FROM THE SENATE OPERATING ACCOUNT TO THE EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP ALLIANCE FOR THE GUEST SPEAKER SERIES: HOW TO LAND A TENURE TRACK POSITION.
- II. ALL UNUSED FUNDS SHALL REVERT BACK TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION AT THE END OF THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR.
- III. SEE ATTACHED BUDGET.
- IV. THE EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP ALLIANCE SHALL REPORT BACK TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION WITHIN 30 DAYS UPON COMPLETION OF THE EVENT.
