#### Crowdfunding Effort Provides Extensive support to Summer High School Research Program

Thanks to the support of many generous donors, AMRI's first efforts at crowdfunding have been a big success. Started in early April, the ~5-week campaign generated funds allowing for support of 4 high school students from the Greater New Orleans area. With over 50 donors providing between \$10 and \$1000, we were able raise over \$8000. All of the funds were then used to provide stipends for the 4 students. These funds, plus additional funding from other sources then allowed us to recruit 6 excellent students into the summer program (see story below).




## AMRI Summer Outreach Program


