- 3. Update from Faculty Senate President (N. Anthony)
- 4. News from the UNO Office of the President (M. Amouzegar)
 - We are 27% towards our \$50 million fundraising goal. The deans are very involved at this point. The campaign cabinet has all given, and the group met recently.
 - Enrollment remains the top priority. Emphasizing applicants likely to enroll, so looking for higher yields, rather than simply applicant numbers. Likely to see fewer apps, but more enrollments.
 - Car beak-ins: Has been a recent issue. We are down 2-3 UNO police officers, with
 positions approved, but hired not yet made. Have hired private security firm until these
 hires are made. Campus access restrictions will be ongoing.
 - Follett textbook program experienced growing pains as predicted. They will have extended hours in early fall semester.
 - Nunez partnership in the works, some MOU's being drafted. President is a UNO alumnus. Looking at offering courses across campuses.

Question from T. Wang on D, F, W rate for courses (which have been given increasing scrutiny in our efforts to retain current students). His concern that some courses have high rates due to challenging material required for further courses.

M. Amouzegar responds that high rates are simply flag to see what's going on, and to see if thing s are OK. AA is not dictating pass rates or compromising academic freedom.

5. Introduction of the new Vice President for Business Affairs, Gloria Walker
Looking at accounts payable and procurement processes. Looking for early-pay discounts for
some contracts. We have had deficits, including last year. Currently hiring a travel card manager
and an experienced accounts payable manager. Currently re-bidding the facilities services
contract- we are the only UL System school with outsourced facilities. Supervising outsourced



contracts is different, and this is UNO's first one. Bringing locksmith back in house after complaints about delays.

6. Foreign collaborations/Security Committee, Office of Research (Matt Tarr) Research wards will be March 10, 2 PM in UC Ballroom.
UG student travel awards are active- they will pay 50% of travel cost.
External grants F&A rate is 46%

Planning new faculty institute (3 sessions in fall, 3 in spring)- sessions to deal with research and teaching.

New Initiatives:

Data Mgmt Committee: Create, share, and secure data across all areas of research Int'l collaboration Risk Mgmt Committee: Foster collaboration and mitigate the inherent risks.

Question from N. Anthony about any restrictions on international visitors.

Reply for M. Tarr: Current process for guest scholars is working, and will continue. Would like to close the gap on some informal int'l visitors that currently aren't registered with the university.

Question from F. Aidoo: What are the connections to the Institutional Review Board for the 2 aforementioned initiatives? Answered offline.
