Yes, this is senator amber Johnson on College of Liberal Arts. I'm speaking on behalf of Brendan Mott. here's his report. Last week before hurricane zeta struck, our committee was able to meet with Amanda Robins, the director of residential life and the area coordinator for Pontchartrain Hall south. Many of our committee members expressed concerns with maintenance specifically plumbing, it was expressed to us on the plumbing infrastructure in the building is not up to code as the pipes used in the building are no longer allowed to be used in commercial construction in the state of Louisiana. In addition, whenever a plumbing issue arises in either building, the water must be turned off for the entire complex because there is no riser switches in the complex which would allow the water to be turned off in parts of the building. In addition at the end of the sodexo, contract, Sodexo stopped responding to maintenance requests. So ABM had to start earlier than expected and had to catch up on months of backlog maintenance issues once their contract formally began on September 1. On the dining side of things I'm currently working on drafting an email to the director of Dining Services about trying to schedule an end of the semester feedback for students who live on campus.
