2021-22 University Design Competition for Addressing Airport Needs Airport Cooperative Research Program

The Airport Cooperative Research Program (ACRP) is offering the University Design Competition for Addressing Airport Needs for U.S.-based undergraduate and/or graduate students to design innovative solutions that address airport issues to enhance the management, safety, capacity and efficiency of the nation's airports. Winning design proposals receive cash awards up to \$3,000, and first place winners present their work at the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine and at a professional conference relating to their work. The competition also provides students with exposure to aviation and airport-related careers.

Research Awards Program (RAP) Louisiana NASA EPSCoR

The RAP sub-program is designed for those researchers who have made a NASA contact and are ready to take the next step of initiating a small project. The goal here is to develop larger, longer-lasting collaborative projects that can transition to the next level.

Notices of Intent (NOIs) are required and are due on Friday, December 3, 2021. Proposals from PIs who have submitted a compliant NOI will be accepted until midnight on Friday, January 7, 2022.
