Periodic Review of Chairs: To ensure quality and effectiveness of Chairs and to maintain the confidence of the faculty, each chair must be formally reviewed during the fall semester of the third year of each term of an academic Department/School Chair. The department/school faculty or an elected department/school committee, in consultation with the Dean, will develop procedures, criteria, and necessary instruments, such as survey questionnaires and/or feedback forms for evaluating the Chair's performance. A college may elect to use a standard procedure for the review of all its Chairs; The Dean will also provide his or her individual review using the *Dean's Evaluation Form* and shall report the results of the reviews of performance to the Provost by January 15.
