Purpose: The Palmisano Foundation Scholarship Fund awards an annual

scholarship to incoming or currently enrolled full-time University student(s) based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an express interest in pursuing an education within the

Architectural, Engineering, or Construction Industry.

Criteria Eligibility: Eligible candidates must have received a letter of acceptance from a

state accredited University, must have 3.0 cumulative grade-point average, complete and sign attached application and furnish all

required attachments.

Amount: \$2,500/semester, \$5,000 annually (contingent upon continued 3.0

semester GPA) to be paid directly to the institution.

Deadline: March 21st, 2022

Award: Interview selections will be made following the review by the

foundation board of the fully completed application submissions. Interviews will take place between April 11th and April 15th or as adjusted by the board. No later than April 29th the Palmisano

Foundation shall notify the recipient(s) of the scholarship award.

Renewal: Renewal will be based on an annual re-enrollment process which shall

include the criteria for continued eligibility for this scholarship. The criteria is included in the Scholarship application and shall be followed accordingly by the recipient(s). Through such re- enrollment process, recipient may be eligible for this award for up to four years. Renewal

applicant must submit their official transcript by July 1st.
