## Microaggressions Everywhere 4/5/22 5:30 PM UC 201A

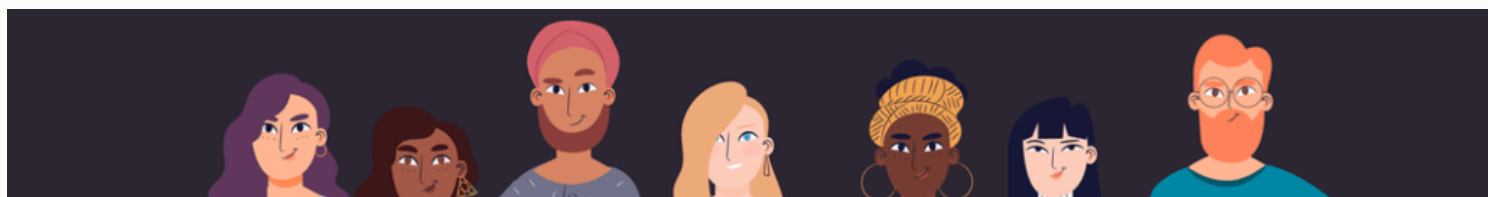
