

## **COVID-19: Pre-Departure & Flight**

- As mentioned in our pre-departure orientations and materials, COVID-19 Booster is strongly recommended for anyone who is has not yet received one of the updated Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines. <u>See here for</u> detailed information from the CDC.
- Read <u>CDC recommendations for international travel</u>.
- Immunocompromised individuals at increased risk for severe COVID-19 should discuss travel plans with doctor and UNO-Innsbruck program administration.
- 7-10 days prior to departure safeguard against contracting COVID-19 by masking, distancing, and good hygiene
  protocols.
- COVID-19 test before departure is encouraged. If positive, do not travel! Inform UNO-Innsbruck and insurance (for insurance coverage to apply via Trip Interruption Benefit, you must receive a lab-administered COVID-19 test)
- Flight: N-95 mask highly recommended and possibly required on flight. Bring one!
- Proof of vaccination not required for entry into Austria, but may be in other countries. We encourage you to bring proof of vaccination in official paper or digital form.

## **COVID-19: During Program**

- There is no mask mandate in the dorm or the university. We encourage you to wear an N-95 mask in crowded settings and transportation, and we urge you to wear a mask if exposed to Covid-19.
- If symptoms, first take an at-home test! Report positive result to UNO-Innsbruck nurse or administration. You will
  need to get a lab-administered test if you want the insurance to reimburse you for any expenses.
   Bring 4 tests!
- Weekend travel: Follow <u>State Department advisories</u>! Complete <u>weekend travel log</u> before departure. Inform
  yourself of any COVID restrictions and guidelines. Wear N-95 masks on transportation and in crowded settings.

## **COVID-19**: Departure to U.S.

- If you test positive with a lab-administered test and are unable to depart as scheduled:
  - The cost of additional lodging and meals may be covered by the Travel Delay Benefit included in our insurance policy (maximum of \$2,000 subject to \$200 per day).
  - Flight change/rebooking fees may be covered by Trip Interruption Benefit included in our insurance policy (maximum of \$2,500)
- Keep documentation of your positive COVID test as well as copies of:
  - Your lodging and meal receipts
  - Your original and new flight itinerary as well as proof of purchase of your change/rebooking fee (i.e. receipt)
