→ PRIVATEER ENROLLMENT CENTER HELP DESK

Enrollment Services seeks **3 graduate students** for the Privateer Enrollment Center Help Desk to assist students and parents with questions regarding admissions, financial aid, and other areas on campus.

The position pays tuition (not fees) and a \$12 hourly wage in the federal work study program. Students must have a 23-24 FAFSA on file and be able to work in shifts of 8:30 -12:30, 12:30-4:30, or 10:00-2:00 Monday through Friday, 20 hours per week. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA and be enrolled in in at least 6 credit hours (half time enrollment) as a degree-seeking student.

The purpose of the NSF Graduate Research Fellowship Program (GRFP) is to ensure the quality, vitality, and diversity of the scientific and engineering workforce of the United States. GRFP seeks to broaden participation in science and engineering of underrepresented groups, including women, minorities, persons with disabilities, and veterans. The five-year fellowship provides three years of financial support inclusive of an annual stipend of \$37,000.
