## Approval of Minutes

### Announcement: Karen Paisant and Mamie Gasperecz

- Telework policy is currently under review, all policies will end by 6/30/2024. Dr. Johnson intends to create a stronger sense of campus community so we can support our students better. Feels lacking with our current situation. We need to do more to support our students.
- There's been a lot of confusion about telework alerts in workday. That should eliminate confusion.
- Going forward we want to encourage a positive work environment. Check in with people on work from home days. Make sure they're supported. In the future all telework will be approved all the way up the chain
- Any questions should go to HR and will be vetted up
- Summer compressed option is under review as well.

## Guest Speaker: Mark Pyle, Associate Vice President, Facility Services. Bernhard Savings Update

Where we are with the Bernhard project:

- Long term commitment, pretty significant endeavour we've engaged with
- 37million dollar investment into our infrastructure of our campus
- 7 projects (some visible, some not)
- Fixing everything that was broken so we're better able to modulate our energy expenditure
- Over 3000 panels (4 acres) of solar! First panels installed yesterday. hopefully in service by the end of april .we need entergy's permission to use it after the transformer is installed

- We have exceeded our target savings by nearly double - mostly because we're ahead of schedule in installing things. So we're capturing savings early.
- With bernhard and reduction in fuel cost charge from entergy, we've saved \$700k between 2022 and 2023

Question: Will some of the fenced-in area of the Solar Panel project be released for parking after completion?

The work fence will be replaced with a nicer fence, so the perimeter will be the same but it will look nicer. Regulations around fencing around solar panels that will have to be complied with, including access for maintenance

We had to take down a big light post. that will be replaced in about a month.
