ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I move in later than August 10-11 (New Students) or August 15/16 (Returner)?

If you are unable to move-in between these times on the scheduled hours, please email ResidentialLife@uno.edu to coordinate an alternative move-in date/time.

What should I do to plan for my arrival on-campus?

Please be on time. Your check-in time is for you to retrieve your key (if you do not have it already), complete our check-in paperwork, and have your ID programmed by an Office of Residential Life staff member at the front desk of your hall. Be sure to get your UNO ID **prior** to coming to check-in, you will need It to be checked-in.

Where do I pick up mail and packages on-campus?

There is a post office located on campus. You must set up a mailbox with them. They are located in the University Center. There is also a post office box rental fee associated with mailbox set up. Please do not send mail to the halls, as it will be sent back. Additional information can be found on their website www.uno.edu/uc/kiosk

I need to get a UNO ID Card before I check-in. How do I get one?

The ID Card Office will be open Monday- Friday between the hours of 9 am- 4 pm on the first floor of the Computer Center Building next to the Earl K Long Library for students to pick up their ID. Students who lost their ID will have to purchase a new one.

What if my roommates and I do not work out?

You are highly encouraged to complete the Roommate Agreement posted to your Residential Life app before beginning a roommate relationship as the items discussed during the Roommate Agreement process will assist in building a strong roommate relationship and understanding. Be open and honest during this discussion. If you are still having issues, contact your RA for assistance with mediation. If the issues are unable to be resolved via mediation, contact the Residential Life professional staff at ResidentialLife@uno.edu for additional assistance.

Move-In Times

Have you Scheduled your Move-In time?

Log onto the Residential Life app on myapps.uno.edu to select your move-in time. University ID is required for check-in.

When arriving on campus for move-in, all residents and families must enter by Benjamin Franklin High School. Residents and their families should take St. Anthony Ave. When exiting, residents and families can leave through any of the exits on-campus.
