LSUHSC - New Orleans Bachelor of Science in Public Health

Listed below are the prerequisite courses for admission to the Bachelor of Science in Public Health (BSPH) Program at the LSU Health Sciences Center School of Public Health in New Orleans.

Designed as a 2+2 program, students must complete the prerequisite courses (shown below) and at least 60 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 from an accredited college or university. Students then apply to the BSPH program and complete another 2 years of coursework to finish their undergraduate studies. Note that LSU School of Public Health at the Health Sciences Center in New Orleans has partnered with LSU Online to offer this program.

Program requirements are determined by LSUHSC and admission to the program is on a competitive basis. Applicants are evaluated and accepted by the admissions committee based on their academic credentials, work and service experience. Admissions will be made on a rolling basis for students entering the program in January, May, or August of each year.

	ENGL 1158 (3 hours) – English Composition II: Credit in ENGL 1157
Mathematics Statistics	Required – 6 hours
	MATH 1115 (3 hours) – College Algebra: Minimum ACT Math score of 19
	OR
	Other MATH courses higher than MATH 1115 can be substituted
	MATH 2314 (3 hours) – Elementary Statistical Methods: Credit in MATH 1115 or higher or 6 hours of mathematics courses numbered at least 1000
Social Sciences	Required – 9 hours
	Choose from Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Political Science, Psychology, or Sociology
Humanities	Required – 9 hours
	Choose from English (2000 or above), Foreign Language, Philosophy, Communications, or History
Art Electives	Required – 3 hours
	Recommended subjects are Music, Art, Dance, or Theater
Natural Sciences	Required – 12 hours
	Choose from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Earth & Environmental Science (At least 3 hours must be in Biology.
General Electives	Required - 15 hours
Total Credits	60 hours
