## Our Mission

It is the mission of the University of New Orleans Fraternity & Sorority Life Office to provide guidance, resources, and support to all of our Greek letter social fraternities and sororities. With a community of 180+ members spread across fourteen organizations and three councils, we take pride in the endeavors of our individual students and the life skills that they can learn within Greek letter organizations.



## New Member Recruitment

This graph tracks the number of new members at certain time intervals throughout the year



This year, our IFC performed strongly against projections, resulting in a net community growth of 14.47% over the last year. Panhellenic (PHC) had a smaller showing in raw numbers, but experienced an extremely impressive 32.08% growth as a community. NPHC also had a proportionally strong year, experiencing 27.27% growth and raising its average chapter size. Our community continues to show strong signs of life and growth even amidst institutional instability.




