

LSU TRANSITION BADGE & COPY REFERENCE STANDARDS

TRANSITION BADGE STANDARDS

- The LSU New Orleans (LSUNO) transition badge should never appear smaller than 1.5 inches in width.
- There must be a protected area surrounding the logo. 50% of the height of the logo should be the minimum space on all sides. (See illustration below.)
- The LSUNO transition badge may only appear in the official LSU colors: purple, gold, black, white, and gray. The logo must appear using 100% full saturation of the official colors. Tinting is not allowed. The PMS, CMYK, and RGB mixes for the LSU colors are listed in the chart below.
- Drop shadows and gradients may never be applied to the LSUNO transition badge.
- The LSUNO transition badge may not be incorporated into other logos or aligned with artwork to create a new logo. Borders, boxes, or shapes may not be placed around or behind the LSUNO transition badge, including a white box.
- The LSUNO transition badge should appear in coordination with institutional branding whenever possible.

COPY REFERENCE STANDARDS

- In written and verbal communication, LSU New Orleans should always be referred to as LSU New Orleans or LSUNO on second reference.
- LSU New Orleans should never be referred to as Louisiana State NOLA, LSU NO, L.S.U.N.O., or other aliases different from the official names listed above.
- LSU New Orleans should always be in upper and lowercase letters or all uppercase letters—never all lowercase letters.
- LSUNO should always appear in all uppercase letters. It should never appear in lowercase letters (lsuno) except for URLs.

TRANSITION BRAND TIMELINE

The LSU New Orleans transition badge will serve as a secondary badge that can be added to LSU and UNO communications as UNO shifts to use of the new LSU New Orleans logos in the summer of 2026. Use of this transition badge will phase out and should no longer be used following the formal incorporation of LSU New Orleans on July 1, 2026. A comprehensive brand guide for the formal LSU New Orleans permanent logo and updated seal is in development and will be available no later than March 1, 2026.

TRANSITION LOGO STANDARDS

- The LSU New Orleans (LSUNO) transition logo should never appear smaller than 1 inch in width.
- There must be a protected area surrounding the logo. The height of the letter "S" in the LSU New Orleans or LSUNO logo should be the minimum space on all sides. (See illustration below.)
- The LSUNO transition logos may only appear in the official LSU colors: purple, gold, black, white, and gray. The logo must appear using 100% full saturation of the official colors. Tinting is not allowed. The PMS, CMYK, and RGB mixes for the LSU colors are listed in the chart below.
- Drop shadows and gradients may never be applied to the LSUNO transition logo.

COPY REFERENCE STANDARDS

- LSU New Orleans should always be in upper and lowercase letters or all uppercase letters—never all lowercase letters.
- LSUNO should always appear in all uppercase letters. It should never appear in lowercase letters (lsuno) except for URLs.

TRANSITION BRAND TIMELINE

The LSU New Orleans transition logo will serve as a primary logo that can replace all UNO marks. Use of this transition logo will phase into a version that removes the "Summer 2026" ribbon following the formal incorporation of LSU New Orleans on July 1, 2026. A comprehensive brand guide for the permanent LSU New Orleans logo and updated seal is in development and will be available no later than March 1, 2026.
