Bobby Anspach Studios Foundation Major Grants and Emerging Artist Grants

Notice seeking applications from visual artists across any medium and at any career stage. Focus areas include: environmental consciousness and climate awareness; human connection and empathy; and transformative and consciousness-raising practices.

Applications are due December 30, 2025. Five awards are anticipated. Three will be for emerging artists at \$8,000 each, and two will be major grants at \$50,000 each.

Fine Arts Work Center Writing Fellowships

ETH AI Center Doctoral Fellowships

Notice seeking applications for one of Europe's premier PhD programs focused on advancing interdisciplinary AI research. This can be inside AI foundations or between AI foundations and application areas. Fellows work with two excellent PIs from different fields who carry equal weight in supervision.

Applications are due November 7, 2025. Approximately five to eight doctoral positions per cohort. Eligibility is limited to applicants who hold (or are close to completing) a Master's degree in computer science, machine learning, statistics, physics, engineering, mathematics, or a related field; meet the doctoral admission requirements at ETH Zurich; have an excellent academic record and research potential; and are fluent in English.

Simons Postdoctoral Fellowships in Plant Biology

Notice seeking applications for postdoctoral fellowships to support candidates who intend to pursue a career in basic research on fundamental problems in plant biology.

Applications are due December 4, 2025. The award is for three years, contingent upon satisfactory progress, and will include an annual stipend of \$85,000 and an annual allowance of up to \$35,000. Future of Life Institute Fellowship in AI Existential Safety

Notice seeking applications to support PhD students who plan to work on AI existential safety research, or for existing PhD students who would not otherwise have funding to work on AI existential safety research.

Applications are due November 21, 2025.
