Workplace Innovation Now Challenge

Notice seeking proposals to discover and scale innovative solutions to help women thrive and help everyone win in a rapidly changing workplace. The initiative aims to address barriers like caregiving responsibilities and biases that tend to disproportionately impact women. Milken Institute Frontotemporal Dementia Grant Program

Notice seeking applications to fund a third cohort of research studies to understand the fundamental biology of why and how sporadic forms of frontotemporal dementia (FTD) develop. In partnership with the

Milken Institute Science Philanthropy Accelerator for Research and Collaboration (SPARC), the program aims to broaden the foundational knowledge of FTD to spur diagnostic and therapeutic advancements.
