Andy Warhol Foundation Curatorial Research Fellowships

Notice seeking proposals that present the topic for which research is being undertaken in narrative form. It can be helpful to discuss the origin of the applicant's interest in the topic, the work undertaken to date; it is expected that projects will evolve over the course of the research and outcomes need not be predicted. Strong proposals explore topics that are understudied and artists whose practices (or aspects of whose practices) are experimental, hard to categorize, and otherwise less well known to the general public.

Proposals are due by September 1, 2025. A letter of support from the director of the sponsoring organization must accompany the proposal. Multiple grants are anticipated with each grant having a maximum of \$50,000.
