Notice seeking proposals for well-designed public diplomacy projects that advance U.S. government priorities and strengthen people-to-people ties between the United States and Slovenia. Priority areas are broadly defined to include democracy and human rights; security and defense issues; economic and business development; science, technology and innovation; cultural and artistic exchange; education and research collaboration; and shared values and heritage. Each application must clearly explain how the project aligns with U.S. policy priorities, particularly by enhancing the safety, strength, and prosperity of the American people.

Proposals are due May 12, 2025. Award amounts range from \$5,000 - \$10,000.
