Cultural Institutions for Capital Projects to Reduce Emissions

Notice seeking applications to provide visual arts institutions grants to undertake ambitious sustainability and energy efficiency initiatives that directly address carbon reduction and energy efficiency. The scope of its support is broad, encompassing everything from modest, rapid-response projects to comprehensive efficiency audits and feasibility studies, and extending to financial contributions for significant infrastructural renovations and strategic planning for new buildings and major initiatives. The categories are Catalyst Grants, Scoping Grants, and Technical Assistance Grants.

Applications are due March 28, 2025. Grants up of \$15,000 are available for Catalyst awards. Grants up to \$25,000 are available for Scoping awards. Grants up to \$50,000 are available for Technical Assistance awards.

Accelerating Innovations to Address Heavy Menstrual Bleeding in Women in Low-Resource Settings

Notice seeking proposals for research on heavy menstrual bleeding (HMB) that focus on 1) biological mechanisms; 2) epidemiology and impact 3) measurement and standardization; 4) innovative diagnostics; 5) treatment and access. Proposals should focus on original research and development and the needs of women in Sub-Saharan Africa, India, and/or Pakistan. While researchers can be based globally, study populations for data collection or intended beneficiaries for new diagnostics and treatments must be from these regions.
