Discussion Items

1. The quorum decided that a minimum of 6 votes is required for approving an undergraduate proposal online and a minimum of 3 votes for approving a graduate proposal.
2. Separate proposals should be submitted for changing or adding 4xxx/5xxx courses. There should be a difference in the student learning outcomes, assignments and assessment of the courses. The graduate level course should require more rigor compared to the undergraduate course.
3. The committee also discussed the drawbacks of having undergraduate courses as prerequisites for graduate level courses and how it should be discouraged.

4. All curriculum changes should be accompanied by the new 4-year plan also, otherwise it would not be reviewed by UCCC.
5. The Add course, Add curriculum and change courses (not fast track), will be voted on in person.
6. UCCC will meet one more time before the end of the semester.
7. Fast track forms should only be used to make minimal or unsubstantiated changes to the courses and curriculum. It should not be used in lieu of add, change and drop course or curriculum form. Such extensive changes on fast track forms will not be accepted by UCCC.
8. Just a reminder that no course number change proposals will be accepted.
9. Some courses have “offered every semester” as a part of course description. This is redundant information and might create problems if the course is not offered every semester.
