Applying for External Funding

- Some awards require submission by fulltime faculty or staff
- You can "piece" together awards to cover total costs
- Professional organizations offer opportunities too

Student Financial Aid

Apply for FAFSA (free application for student aid)

- If you can apply for Federal Student Aid, do it! It can be a backup or bridge you don't have to accept full amount.
- Federal aid regulations are more forgiving than private loans
- Parent info is not required

Applying for FAFSA or external funds

You should never pay for scholarship or grant information. If you receive a prompt for payment, the resource is not legitimate.

Go to .gov sites (not .com)

Other Aid opportunities Veterans Affairs benefits can be applied

- Veterans Affairs benefits can be applied towards graduate education
- ► Teach Grant Master of Arts in Teaching students are eligible; receive \$4000 towards your education in exchange for service in high needs schools
